

ACMA BOARD COMMITTEES

Title	Purpose
Executive	Implements the Board decisions when the Board is not in session (<i>comprised of the Officers of the Board</i>)
Finance	Directs the finances of the Association (<i>must be on the BOD to be on this committee</i>)
Audit	Independently oversees the financial policies, procedures, investments and the annual financial audit (<i>must be on the BOD to be on this committee</i>)
Nominating	Identifies and slates candidates for open Board and Officer seats (<i>must be on BOD to be on this committee</i>)
Membership	Oversees the recruitment and retention of Association members
Awards	Oversees ACMA Awards
CAMX Steering	Per ACMA SAMPE Joint Venture – guides CAMX budget and execution
Strategic Planning	Prepares and guides the ACMA strategic plan
Public Policy Steering	Advises staff on ACMA PAC and government relations strategy
--Regulatory Steering (RSC)	Advises staff on regulatory advocacy and compliance assistance programs
CGI Fund Projects Steering Committee (\$20K)	Comprised of representatives of the 9 Material Suppliers & Distributors, plus past ACMA chairman manufacturers who review and decide on funding for projects from CGI committees
Education & Certification	Reviews educational program efforts, CCT certifications and workforce initiatives. Provides guidance, oversight and reviews proposals for credential updates and program initiatives.
Marketing & Communications	Provides oversight and direction to ACMA marketing and communications activities.
Statistics & Market Intelligence	Provides oversight and direction to the Industry Statistics Program, Pulse of the Industry survey and market intelligence initiatives. Seeks to maximize the breadth and quality of the data generated and ensures it is communicated effectively to ACMA members.
Technical Committee	Provides technical resources to help ACMA [and its] members to prosper
Sustainability Strategy Committee (SSC)	Develops high-level objectives for making composites the sustainable material of preference
